

Psychology Post-Doctoral Fellow 2019-20

The Department of Psychology at The New School for Social Research and Eugene Lang College seek applicants for a postdoctoral fellowship position, to begin August 1, 2019. The duration of the position is for one year. We seek candidates with promise of excellence in research. We are seeking a clinically-minded, technically proficient candidate to prepare papers for publication from a completed grant project on blunted emotionality and physiology within a transdiagnostic sample stratified on trauma exposure. The grant, co-directed by Wendy D'Andrea at the New School and Greg Siegle at the University of Pittsburgh, includes interviews; behavioral tasks; and autonomic, EEG, cortisol, and fMRI data on a sample of over 200 participants. Research supervision and training activities will be shared by Drs. D'Andrea and Siegle, but the position will be housed in New York City. Candidates should be proficient in E-prime and Matlab; fMRI analysis proficiency would be especially helpful.

The position includes a 1:1 teaching load.

Applicants must have defended their PhD by **June 30, 2019** or provide a letter from their advisor and the chair of their department stating that the defense of their dissertation will occur no later than the 2019 fall term (December 31, 2019).
