Clinical training/experience in developmental psychology is preferred, consistent with the scientist-practitioner model. For the **clinical** track, we are seeking an applicant with a strong record of clinical research and clinical training/experience, consistent with the scientist-practitioner model. Licensed or license-eligible clinical psychologist preferred.
