

Post-doc position in the Laboratory of Social & Affective Neuroscience at Georgetown University

Applications are invited for a full-time 2-year post-doctoral position in The Laboratory on Social and Affective Neuroscience in the Department of Psychology at Georgetown University in Washington, DC (**PI: Abigail Marsh**).

The position will be funded by an NSF award to conduct fMRI, behavioral, and neurohormonal research related to the neural basis of empathy, altruism, and interpersonal callousness/psychopathy.

The project offers opportunities to develop skills and expertise in functional and structural neuroimaging combined with neurohormonal research, and to work in a collaborative and supportive social neuroscience lab. The candidate will participate in study design, data collection, analysis, and publications in collaboration with an interdisciplinary team.

The start date is flexible. Interviews will be conducted until the position is filled.

The ideal candidate will have...

- A PhD in psychology, neuroscience, cognitive science, or a closely related field
- Interest and experience in conducting empirical research on the neuroscience of empathy, altruism, aggression, and/or psychopathy
- Experience collecting and analyzing human structural and functional MRI data
- Experience conducting computational analyses of behavioral and/or neuroimaging data
- Strong writing skills
- A publication record commensurate with the candidate's level of training
- Enthusiasm for working as part of a team and taking part in training junior scholars
