Candidates researching topics from Affective Science, Diversity Science, and/or Clinical/Developmental/Social Neuroscience are particularly encouraged to apply, though all areas of expertise will be considered. Successful candidates will grow a research program that strengthens existing collaborations within the department and across the university.

The University of Rochester is a distinguished research university, and the Department of Psychology has a history of excellence in psychological science. It offers outstanding opportunities for developing a research program, highly ranked doctoral programs, a vibrant undergraduate major, and a collaborative environment. The department has Ph.D. programs in Clinical, Developmental and Social-Personality Psychology. There is excellent collaboration among faculty across areas, and close ties to other groups in the University, particularly in Brain and Cognitive Sciences, Education, Psychiatry, Neuroscience, and Pediatrics.
